Organize the class time better to have more structured learning experience. Clearly define the theme and learning outcome for each lecture. Clarify some of the expectations and assignment requirements. Have more office hours.

Carlos could have had a bit more structure to the classes so that less time was wasted at the beginning of class and if a discussion was going on too long it could be cut off.

Sometimes I didn't understand the ethical concepts like intrinsic and utilitarian. Maybe he could explain them in more detail. I was a bit confused about the difference between them.

Form a more structured class, one where we have to refocus and all the students are listening. I felt sometime I would get lost and forget the initial topic, so a more structured class would help with that.
